Objective: Open Needham's first off-leash dog park

With over 3000 licensed dogs, Needham is one of the last towns in the area without a dog park where people can bring their dogs to run around off-leash and socialize with their friends. Newton's multiple dog parks and Wellesley and Dedham's dog parks are widely used. A group of interested people in Needham have been working on Needham's first off-leash dog park and it looks like things are finally in place to make it a reality. From the beginning, we have been working closely with the Town Manager and the Board of Selectmen to make this happen and they have been very supportive and have agreed to handle the ongoing operational costs of running the dog park.

Fundraising for up-front costs

The plan is to locate the dog park at the Nike Site in Needham (next to the Needham Community Farm). Establishing the dog park is going to involve site prep, fencing, and signage, for which the town is asking us to raise the funds. In total, we are estimating the up-front costs will be \$25,000.
